# Outline of Vehicle Inspection Discussion

February 6, 2018

## Modification to KRS 186A.115(1)(a)

- Inspection program open only to licensed automobile dealers selling 250 or more vehicles per year.
- Certification will be designated by the county sheriff following requirements set forth by the department per Section (2)(a) of 186A.115
- Dealership shall provide Bond to participate.
- Sheriff trains individual inspector to Sheriff's satisfaction
- Individuals are certified but only for the specific licensed automobile dealer that is sponsoring.
- Certification does not stay with individual when they leave employment of that sponsoring dealership.
- Completed VTR inspection(s) and appropriate fee(s) shall be transmitted to Sheriff's Office, in the manner specified by the Sheriff, weekly.
- Paperwork submitted shall include the completed VTR and a photo of the automobile's VIN plate.
- Sheriff shall have the authority to review inspection records and observe inspection activities at any time during normal business hours.
