The Nelson Co SO requested that a team of to perform an inventory/audit of the evidence room. The question came up if the members of the team are KSA members who perform this audit/inventory covered by the KSA Liabilty policy. The insurance company stated they are covered in case of issues that may arise from the audit\inventory at no extra cost. A motion was made by Sheriff Jansen that a \$25.00 fee would be paid to the KSA if an office request this to be done, 2nd by Sheriff Stager.

The Board approved the motion.
